At NBSC Balgowlah Boys Campus, we offer a comprehensive Band Program that caters for instrumentalists of all skill levels and tastes. The School Bands are involved in performances at school assemblies, awards days and showcases, as well as external eisteddfods and festivals. The program assists students in reaching their musical goals, whilst refining their ensemble skills by having access to highly-experienced teachers and conductors.

The offered bands and their rehearsal times are:

- Junior Concert Band (Year 7 – 8) – Friday, 7:30am in the School Hall
- Senior Concert Band (Year 9 – 12) – Tuesday, 7:30am in the School Hall
- Stage Band (all years, auditioned) – Thursday, 7:30am in the School Hall
- Improvisation ensemble (all years) – Wednesday, 7:30am in the Music Studio
- Saxophone ensemble (all years) – Friday lunchtime in DS7

The Band Program welcomes musicians of all skill levels and backgrounds and aims to foster the enjoyment of playing music with peers.

Rehearsals will begin Week 3, Term 1 (week beginning 10th February 2020)

Registration and Requirements

- In order to provide students with the best access to repertoire, experienced external conductors and the maintenance of band resources, we ask for a fee of \$350 per student for the year. Please complete the payment form on the following page and return it to the Front Office. If there is an issue meeting this payment, please contact the Music Staff.
- Students are required to complete and return the agreement form attached to this letter in acknowledgement of the Terms and Conditions of the Band Program.

Terms and Conditions

- Students are required to attend all weekly rehearsals.
- All students are required to participate in internal and external performances.
- Any absences must be communicated to the Music Staff with ample notice.
- Students are required to organise a folder for their sheet music, and ensure it is up to date when new sheet music is distributed. It is the student's responsibility to maintain this folder.
- Students are to adhere to the Balgowlah Boys behaviour standards throughout all rehearsals and performances.
